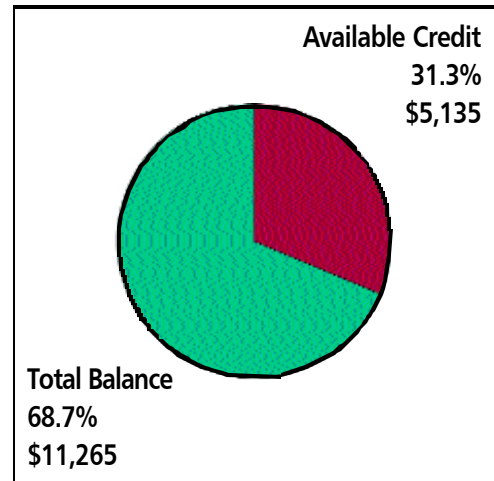

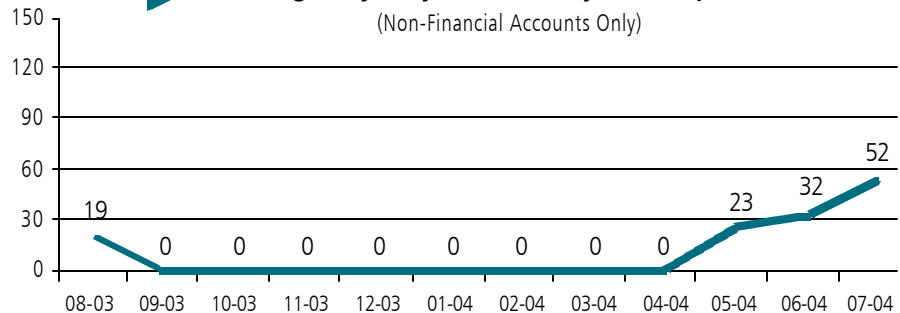

A graphical trend chart displays the dollar-weighted average days beyond terms on a month-by-month basis, providing insight into the payment habits of the business.
